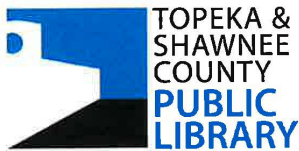
Documents that can be prepared for free

Experts will present a 30-minute program at 1:30pm. Then **attendees 60+** can talk one-on-one with a KLS staff member to have advance directive legal documents drafted for free. Simple Wills and Transfer on Death Deeds can be prepared at an appointment later.
